

SDHSAA Ticket Information – State Wrestling

SDHSAA Athletic Directors:

Please find attached information regarding SDHSAA State Wrestling Tickets as well as an order form for seating. Please note the following information regarding this year's combined tournament event:

- Tickets for the State Wrestling Tournament will be sold by Summit Arena at The Monument in Rapid City. Member schools should only submit one order per school. This order must be received by Summit Arena at The Monument prior to January 31. Orders received after January 31 will be assigned after all of those who were received prior to the deadline.
- Orders will be filled by a drawn lot as to best accommodate all ticketing orders, and not given priority on a first-come, first-serve basis. Orders can be submitted at any time following the receipt of these forms.
- Note that all adult tickets are sold as "Reserved Seats." The arena will be split into half. Seats in the lower bowl will be filled first, followed by upper bowl seating. This may include some overlap of sections and classes to fill the 'best seats first.' After all lower bowl seats are sold, orders will then be placed into the upper bowl.
- All student tickets are "general admission" and will allow students to sit in the designated student sections (209-211 of the upper deck). If a student wishes to sit in any other section, they must purchase a full-priced, reserved-seat ticket.
- Note that sections have been given preliminary designations. If the ticket sales dictate, some of the sections listed as "student" sections may become reserved-seat. Additionally, Standing Room Only tickets may be sold if necessary.
- Floor access will be limited to competitors and those with mat passes.
- All rounds of wrestling will occur in The Monument.
- Ticket orders for the Tournament should be sent directly to The Monument Box Office 444 Mt. Rushmore Road North, Rapid City, SD 57701
- Each order must be accompanied by a single, school check or money order for the exact amount of that order. Checks must be made payable to The Monument.
- **Only All-Session Tickets may be ordered in advance.** There will be NO REFUNDS on ticket orders.
- Full Ticketing information is on the next page, the form to remit with your ticket order is on the third page.

Passes and Complimentary Tickets at State Tournament

1. Each contestant will be furnished a pass. (SDHSAA Punch Ticket)
2. Each Varsity Cheerleader in attendance will be furnished a pass, but not granted floor access. They will only be allowed to cheer during individual and team dual championships. (SDHSAA Punch Ticket)
3. Student manager passes will be provided. (SDHSAA Punch Ticket, per season roster, maximum of two per team)
4. Complimentary tickets will be issued to a school as follows: (Coaches/Admin need to use these to enter, SDHSAA Pass)

Number of Qualifiers(Pass)	Complimentary Tickets
1	3
2	4
3	5
4 or more	6

One pass for a bus driver will be available if requested.

The High School Press Pass Request form is located in the School Zone, Fine Arts, Journalism section.

**Passes will be issued to the coach at the time of check-in for distribution to his school members.

D. State Tournament Reserved Seat Ticket Information – Combined Tournament, Rapid City

1. Member School Pre-Sale Ticket Orders
 - a. Only all-tournament tickets will be sold in advance.
 - b. Tickets for the Combined Tournament will be sold only by The Monument in Rapid City. Ticket Order forms will be sent to Member Schools in the first two weeks of January. There is no limit on the number of adult or student all-tournament tickets a school can purchase.
 - c. Each school order must be accompanied by a check or money order made payable to The Monument for the exact amount of the order.
 - d. The deadline for School Orders to be received by The Monument is January 31. Any orders received after that point will be filled in the order they are received and potentially mixed in with general public sales.
 - e. There are NO REFUNDS on ticket orders
2. General Public Pre-Sale Orders
 - a. The general public is encouraged to make their orders through their local school district to ensure they receive priority seating for the Tournament.
 - b. Members of the general public not ordering tickets through their school may contact the host site directly or purchase tickets online beginning on or around February 1.
 - c. As with the school orders, there are NO REFUNDS on any tickets purchased.
3. Ticket Prices:

4. Ticket Specifications:
 - a. All adults will be required to purchase a reserved seat ticket good for seating as assigned to gain entry.
 - b. Students wishing to sit with their school/parent groups must purchase a reserved seat ticket.
 - c. Discounted student tickets will be for seating in specified sections separate from team personnel.
 - d. Student Tickets are good for those in Grades 1-12. Kindergarten or younger are admitted free, but not necessarily provided a seat in the reserved section without a ticket. College students are considered adults and must purchase an adult ticket to gain entry.
 - e. Tickets may be purchased on the day of the event. Doors will open 90 minutes prior to the first session on Friday and 60 minutes prior to each of the remaining sessions.
